2. Forced Air Unit Heaters

The most economical option for heating, forced air unit heaters are easy to install, provide low initial cost and high efficiency. Heaters are available in natural or propane gas. Stacks and heater hanging kits are available.

Distribution of the heat produced by forced air unit heaters is facilitated by Horizontal Air Flow (HAF) fans or less commonly, fan jets. The best application for your facility is accomplished with various sizes, quantities and manufacturers of HAF fans and fan jets.

3. Hot Water Heat

Among the most fuel efficient heating options, hot water is available as in-floor, under bench, and perimeter configurations. Utilizing boilers operating on natural gas, propane or electric, hot water heat provides a balanced environment.
